Pre-K Re-entry

- ❑ October 19, 2020: face to face instruction begins
- ❑ Hours of operation: 7:30am - 2:15pm
- ❑ Schedule: M, Tu, Th, F - face to face;
Wednesday - Remote Instruction



Face Coverings/Social Distancing

- ❑ Face coverings are strongly encouraged for preschool children if they can reliably wear (over the nose and mouth), remove, and handle a mask
- ❑ Social distancing will be used as much as possible in the classroom setting



Classroom set-up

- ❑ Items have been removed from classrooms in effort to prevent contamination
- ❑ Children will play in socially distanced activity centers
- ❑ Children will have assigned seating for meals and Circle time (Remote Moments)
- ❑ Upon arriving to school, children will remain in their classroom with the exception of Gross Motor time



Arrival ~ Car Riders

- ❑ 7:15am - 7:25am - Car riders dropped off
- ❑ Use the lanes closest to the building for drop off
- ❑ Daily Health Screenings will be conducted, including temperature checks prior to children getting out of vehicles
- ❑ ***Children with temperatures greater than 100.4 will not be permitted in the building***
- ❑ Staff will unload children and parents should remain in their vehicles if screening is successful



Late Arrivals

- ❑ **If you arrive after 7:30am**, you will need to park your car in the parking lot and walk to the main entrance
- ❑ Daily Health Screenings will be conducted on the child prior to parent leaving campus
- ❑ Children will be escorted to class by a staff member after successfully completing the screening



Arrival ~ Bus Riders

- ❑ Prior to getting on the bus, a Daily Health Screening will be conducted by monitor/driver
- ❑ ***Children with temperatures greater than 100.4 will not be permitted on the bus***
- ❑ Monitor/Driver will buckle your child into their seat on the bus
- ❑ Parents are not permitted on the bus
- ❑ Buses will arrive to school by 7:20am



Changes in Bus Transportation

- ❑ Bus changes - to change your child's pick-up or drop-off location, a transportation form is required
- ❑ [Bus Transportation Request Form](#)
- ❑ Transportation will take a minimum of one week to process due to social distancing guidelines



Visitors

- ❑ Only essential visitors will be allowed on campus in effort to protect the health and safety of our community by minimizing the number of people on site
- ❑ Visitors must have an appointment to gain entrance to the building
- ❑ Visitors will have to complete a Daily Health Screening



Meals

- ❑ Children will be provided breakfast and lunch at school with no cost
- ❑ Children will eat their meals in the classroom at an assigned seat to support social distancing
- ❑ Children may bring their lunch to school; lunches must meet child care nutritional guidelines

Unique Mealtime Needs

- ❑ If your child has an allergy to food or needs other accommodations for mealtimes, a form must be completed for the cafeteria
- ❑ [Unique Mealtimes Form](#)
- ❑ Parents may need to send in replacement items to meet nutritional guidelines for children



Water

- ❑ Children may bring water bottles to school
- ❑ Refillable water bottles may also be used
- ❑ Children will not be able to use water fountains



Rest Time & Extra set of clothes

- ❑ Children should bring a blanket or towel for rest time
- ❑ Rest time items will be sent home on Tuesdays and Fridays for laundering
- ❑ Parents should send an extra set of clothes in a gallon ziplock bag in case of an accident



Dismissal

- ❑ Early pickups - child must be picked up no later than 1:45pm
- ❑ Dismissal begins at 2:05pm
- ❑ Individuals picking-up children must be on the child's Emergency Contact form
- ❑ Upon request of staff, individual must show driver's license for identification



Dismissal ~ Car Riders

- ❑ Parents will use the lanes closest to the building to pick-up their child; they should pull all the way down the lane and should be in place by 2:05pm
- ❑ Staff will ask your child's name so your child can be escorted to the car
- ❑ Staff will load your child into the car; after loading safely proceed to the exit



Medicine at School

- ❑ Medication Administration form must be completed by parent before a child can be given medication
- ❑ Children with asthma, food allergies, seizures must have a Action Plan along with the Medication Administration forms

- ❑ Topical ointments require another form to be completed



Sick Children

- Check your child for visible signs of sickness
- Keep your child home from school if any of the following symptoms are present:
 - Fever, chills
 - Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
 - New loss of taste or smell, Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting, coughing, fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Sore throat, headache, diarrhea



Isolation Room

- ❑ Children who display COVID-19 symptoms, show signs of illness, or become sick will be placed in an Isolation Room and parents will be contacted
- ❑ Parents/Guardians are expected to promptly pick up their child up



Returning to school after sickness

- ❑ Students who have experienced at least one COVID-19 symptom, with or without being diagnosed with COVID-19, should not be in school.
- ❑ They should stay home until it has been been at least 3 days since they had a fever (without using fever-reducing medicine), cough, shortness of breath



Cleaning/Sanitizing/Disinfecting

- ❑ Pre-K Staff will adhere to all child care guidelines for cleaning, sanitizing, & disinfecting
- ❑ At the end of each day, classrooms will be cleaned by staff and custodians
- ❑ Each Wednesday, a deep cleaning will occur



Required Forms

- ❖ Prior to attending school, your child must have the following completed and in your child's file:
 - Completed application
 - Completed Orientation forms
 - Completed Parent/Legal Guardian Statement of Compliance for COVID-19 Re-entry



Health Assessments/Dental Forms

- ❑ Health Assessments and Dentals Forms are due to your child's teacher no later than October 30, 2020
- ❑ If forms are not turned in, children will be unable to attend school until they have been received



Other:

- ❑ Safety drills will be conducted as required
- ❑ Children are not permitted to bring personal items to school
- ❑ Parents should not send food in for celebrations
