Board of Education Meeting Highlights
February 24, 2014

- Chairman Barry Overman called the meeting to order.
- Superintendent Linwood Williams led the Pledge of Allegiance and Moment of Silence.
- Mr. Overman recognized the guests in attendance.
- The minutes of the January 27 meeting were approved.
- Superintendent Williams, Joyce Harris, and board members recognized two teachers that renewed their National Board Certification this year: Marian MacGowan and Duncan Moore.
- Superintendent Williams presented the Good News Report for February.
- Superintendent Williams reminded board members of the dates and times for several upcoming events.
- Randy Kidd spoke during the Public Forum section of the meeting. Mr. Kidd spoke as Vice-President of the Elizabeth City-Pasquotank Association of Educators (NCAE) regarding the loss of career status and due process rights. Mr. Kidd asked the board to consider passing a resolution to repeal the 25 percent contract.
- The Finance Committee recommended and the Board approved the following:
 - Acceptance of the 2012-13 Audit Report
 - Bids for Northside Elementary Fire Alarm Upgrade and Re-Reroofing of Northeastern High School (Phase IV), as funds become available
- The Board approved the ECPPS 2014-16 Technology Plan as recommended by the Academic Affairs Committee.
- The Board approved contracting with the NC School Board Association to update the Board's policy manual as presented by the Policy Committee.
- The following items were approved as presented by the Personnel Committee: elections, coaches, reassignments and leaves of absence.
