# MINUTES BOARD OF EDUCATION ELIZABETH CITY-PASQUOTANK PUBLIC SCHOOLS October 29, 2018

# IV. Superintendent's Report

Tonight we are pleased to have Ms. Sandy James, Northeastern High School Teacher of the Year.

Ms. Sandy James, 2018-19 Teacher of the Year for Northeastern High School presented information on the honor of being selected as "Teacher of the Year" for Northeastern High School and as a district finalist and what it means to her. Ms. James talked about being an educator for over 20 years at Northeastern High School and is currently a CTE Business Education teacher. Ms. James stated she serves on the FBLA advisor board, SIT team, Prom coordinator, and mentor for new teachers. Ms. James said that one thing she wants to do is leave a legacy as part of the educational system. Ms. James said she has always been an advocate for Northeastern High School and

her heart has always been with her school. Ms. James thanked the Board for having her tonight.

## VII. Board Member Reports

Mrs. Houston commented on the ceremony and unveiling of the P.W. Moore Historical Marker. Mrs. Houston said the entire program and choir under Mr. Jim Lunt was wonderful. She also shared her appreciation to Ms. Crutch concerning a PCHS student.

Mr. Overman gave a shout out to the Northeastern High School tennis team. They made it to the second round of tennis finals. Mr. Overman commented on the cool stuff Mrs. Cobb is doing at Northeastern High School. Mr. Overman also shared information about River Road Middle School sending out weekly updates and offering tutoring for all students.

Ms. Warden also commented about the ceremony at P.W. Moore and how well the choir did. Ms. Warden shared J. C. Sawyer's fall festival and the principal being dunked in the dunking booth. Everyone was having fun and the 5<sup>th</sup> graders raised enough funds to assist with their Washington DC trip. Ms. Warden also mentioned the Northeastern High School video challenge they did at the school.

Mrs. Pureza stated parents are beginning to see positive changes in the district. Mrs. Pureza also commended on the weekly updates parents receive from River Road Middle School.
