Chair Warden called the meeting to order.

Dr. Sanders reported that Convocation was a success and received positive feedback about the event.

Jill Turner, P.W. Moore Elementary School Teacher of the Year, spoke on the honor of being chosen by the teachers at P.W. Moore as Teacher of the Year. She thanked Amber Godfrey, principal Sara English and P.W. Moore staff for this opportunity. Ms. Turner shared that prior to graduating from East Carolina University with a Masters in Library Science; she worked with youth as a counselor and teacher, and in the business world in Management Development and Training and church administration. She indicated that she began working as a teacher/librarian at P.W. Moore five years ago using the skills she developed along the way, because she saw it as a chance to challenge curiosity, to help students develop grit and perseverance, to bring global perspective and bridge an educational gap, to make a difference and change lives.

Ms. Turner shares that she leads in three integrated areas at P.W. Moore: Digital Learning, Literacy and Design as she is transforming the media center into a collaborative learning center that functions as an extension of the classroom. She shares her passions and information about her action research on student reading level data.

In conclusion, Ms. Turner shared that her students write important facts about themselves and their interest on their author pages of their interactive notebooks in hopes that one day you will see their bios in an article or in a book. She says, "At P.W. Moore, we are life changers".
