MINUTES BOARD OF EDUCATION ELIZABETH CITY-PASQUOTANK PUBLIC SCHOOLS August 21, 2017

The Elizabeth City-Pasquotank Board of Education met on Monday, August 21, 2017, for the purpose of holding Committee Meetings. The Committee Meetings were called to order by Chair Sharon Warden at 2:00 p.m. and were held in the Board Room of the Administration Building.

I. Personalized Education Committee

Jennifer Hawkins, Director of Testing/Accountability, reviewed 2017-18 Alternative Accountability Models for alternative schools as allowed by the State Board of Education. "Option C" (Alternative schools may participate in the Alternative Schools' Progress Model) was recommended for H. L. Trigg Community School. Members approved placing the recommendation for "Option C" on the August 28th consent agenda.

Board members and Superintendent Cartner discussed student transfers, the "Choice" Resolution passed by the Board of Education in 2012 regarding No Child Left Behind "school choice" ending and the requirement for kindergarten students to attend their school of assignment. It was decided that the Resolution is no longer applicable and Superintendent Cartner will investigate revising the current policy regarding student transfers or develop an administrative regulation regarding requiring kindergarten students to attend their school of assignment.
