Dr. Cartner provided copies of the district newsletter "Let's Connect – ECPPS News & Information" to members.

Dr. Cartner shared that the "ECP Backpacks" program is up and running with 275 students being served. He noted that the program was formed this year through the Education Foundation and in partnership with Food Bank of the Albemarle to provide weekend food for students who may not have adequate nutritional meals when not in school. It is a community supported group with well over 20 churches and organizations working together to help eliminate hunger.

Mr. Joshua Sawyer, 2017-18 Teacher of the Year Representative for Northeastern High School presented information on what being selected as a "Teacher of the Year" for his school and as a district finalist has meant to him. He talked about connecting with students and making a difference in their lives, the need to go beyond the standard and to never let any student give up.
