Board members commented on meetings attended in the community; meetings held at schools (Book Nights, PTA Meetings, Playground Ribbon Cutting, Open House, H. L. Trigg Anniversary Celebration, etc.); Athletic Events; and the ECPPS Parent Academy held recently. They expressed gratitude for community support of schools and the district. They also commented on the resources available within the district for parents.

X. Other

Board members discussed a request submitted by Chief of Police, Eddie M. Buffaloe, Jr., to rename the Sheep-Harney Field the "Jaiden Jones Memorial Field" in honor of Jaiden Jones, ECPPS 2nd grade student and member of the Police Athletic League Rampage players, who passed away on September 7, 2017.

Following heartfelt discussion between all members, a motion was made by Virginia Houston, seconded by Walter Jolly, and unanimously carried to deny the request to rename the Sheep-Harney Field because it does not meet the requirements of Board Policy 9300.

Members discussed other possibilities (such as a "buddy bench" or a plaque) that could be placed at the school Jaiden attended or on the Sheep-Harney Field to honor his memory. Chair Warden will communicate the decision and suggestions to Chief Buffaloe.
