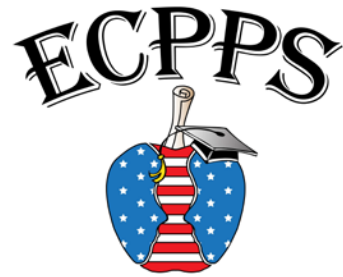


**Elizabeth City-Pasquotank Public Schools

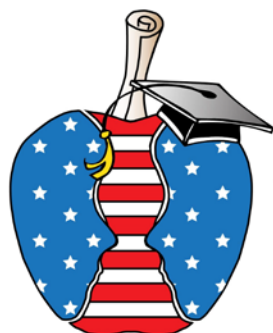
